We named the ÂME vineyard on our Conn Valley Ranch after our three children, taking the first name initial from Alexandra, Michael, and Elizabeth to spell out the French word for “Soul”. David Abreu started the wheels rolling in 1994 when he told us that the vineyard he had just spent two years planting for us would one day be “the soul of Neyers Cabernet.” This three acre parcel rises from 800 ft to 1,200 ft in elevation—much of it at a 45 degree incline—and the south facing slope has been planted with heirloom budwood taken from Abreu’s Thorvilas Vineyard, budwood that originated at Ch. Margaux in France. It’s the highest elevation, rockiest part of our property, and the soil is a mix of gravel with massive hunks of basalt—a limestone-like rock created from heavily compacted volcanic ash. David was right. It is a site perfect for Cabernet Sauvignon.
