Tasting Notes:

The 2015 harvest in Puglia, Italy experienced unusual weather conditions – both high and low temperature extremes. It was a late and long harvest season. Meticulous farming combined with a longer growing season resulted in a complex wine. The long maturation period led to high quality and more aromatics. Puglia, in general, produces richer Sangiovese. This wine is no exception - it is layered with aromas and flavors and is overall a very intriguing yet approachable wine.

Look: Ruby red with purple hue

Nose: Intense aromas of ripe red berries, cherries and strawberries followed by hints of wild flowers, crushed herbs and licorice

Mouth: This medium-bodied blend starts with ripe red fruit, dried earth and pomegranate on the palate, complemented with soft and supple tannins making this wine approachable and easy drinking.
