ABOUT

For the 2016 vintage of the SHOW Cabernet Sauvignon, we turned our attention to California, reinventing the way we make Cabernet. From cool coastal vineyards, to sun-baked valleys to mountainous foothills, it's the diversity of terroir that makes California so special, and we take full advantage of it in our full-throttle Cabernet Sauvignon. The label image memorializes an historic grove of Redwoods in Humboldt County named in honor of one of our trio's ancestors. These giants are humbling, an enduring reminder of the awesome power of nature and the Golden State.

For us, there is no greater inspiration than nature itself. We are Joel Gott, Charles Bieler and Roger Scommegna, a trio of adventure seekers and wine crafters, who look to some of the world's most dramatic backdrops to create the multi-dimensional wines of the SHOW.

WINEMAKING

The blend was aged in a mix of French and American oak, imparting complexity and texture to the finished wine.

TASTING NOTES

A deep red, nearly purple color, with aromatics of concentrated black fruits, cigar box and notes of barrel toast. Dark fruit, spice and rich flavors continue on the palate. Quite brooding, but pure and focused. The tannins are super integrated and soft, but with terrific balance and finish that gives it unusual length in the palate.

VINEYARDS

Our goal was to blend coastal fruit from the North Coast and Central Coast with Cabernet grapes from the inland, and warmer, Lodi region.

ALCOHOL: 13.25% v/v

VARIETAL: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petite Sirah
