“The 2017 Pinot Noir “Wiley Vineyard” from Derek Rohlffs at Bravium is nicely low octane, coming in at 12.5 percent alcohol and offering up admirable purity on both the nose and palate. The bouquet wafts from the glass in a red fruity and youthful blend of cherries, raspberries, a hint of beetroot, mustard seed, fresh thyme, gorgeous soil tones, cedar and a hint of the cola tones to come with bottle age. On the palate the wine is bright, detailed and tangy, with a full-bodied and youthful format, a good core, lovely transparency and a long, moderately tannic and bouncy finish. This is still a young wine and has a nice girdle of acidity to carry it far into the future, but it deserves some time in the cellar to properly blossom. It is going to be excellent.”
