“It has been nearly a year since I tasted a bottle of the 2016 Bravium “Russian River Valley” bottling of Chardonnay and the wine has blossomed beautifully. The nose wafts from the glass in a mix of apple, pear, acacia blossom, alluvial soil tones, a nice touch of almond and a very discreet framing of vanillin oak. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied, focused and complex, with a lovely core of fruit, excellent acids and a long, balanced and beautifully focused finish. This is classic Russian River chardonnay that is opening up beautifully, but has the chassis to age nicely for the next decade or more. Fine juice!”
